The GroupWise platform consists of desktop client software, which is available for Windows, and the server software, which is supported on Linux. In 1987, WordPerfect Library was extended to the PC platform in a DOS version. In 1988, email and calendaring/scheduling debuted in the product, which was also rebranded 'WordPerfect Office 2.0'.
